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NETWORK ID

Your child's network ID is the two digit year they will graduate from high school+last name+first name (e.g. 22linvillekris). Your child's GAFE and Office 365 login is their network ID+@iusd.org (e.g. 22linvillekris@iusd.org). IUSD does not provide email accounts to students. Your child should know their password, if not, please contact their teacher or submit a helpdesk ticket.

PARENT PORTAL

It is a single, secure sign-in for parents or guardians to access a comprehensive view of their students' information including attendance, standardized test scores, and gradebook information (if the student's teacher uses Aeries gradebook).
